Dikson is a well known line designed for long lasting colour and shine. Their newest product line is a one step colour process known as Red Up and Lite Up, designed for the fashion conscious.



The hair styling team, along with Sets Aesthetics team led by Lorraine Lee, will be making future appearances in The Wonderful Wedding Show, which will be held



