

Jewish National Fund Presents Dunam Certificate to Ramah



A Jewish National Fund dunam certificate was presented to the children of the Ramah Hebrew School recently by William S. Pitch, president of the JNF of Winnipeg through Meyer Silverman, principal of the school. Joseph Seter, vice-president of the Midwest region of the Zionist Organization of Canada, spoke to the pupils about his recent visit to Israel and Gad Baler, JNF Israeli emissary to western Canada, brought greetings from the Jewish National Fund in Israel.

PLAN CENTENNIAL PROJECTS

A permanent project to reflect the cultural heritage of the Jewish people was considered by delegates from some 22 Winnipeg organizations at a seminar sponsored by the Jewish Centennial Co-ordinating Committee of Canadian Jewish Congress late last month.

Suggestion for a new Jewish library building or a Jewish section in the Winnipeg Public Library led to a plan to improve library programs by seeking to develop co-operative efforts between the Jewish Public Library and other institutions such as YMHA, Hillel House, the Jewish Schools and other interested organizations who maintain libraries.

A Centennial commemorative event already under way is a Jewish Music Festival Tribute to the Centennial in March under the

auspices of the Jewish Women's Musical Club in co-operation with Canadian Jewish Congress. Other suggestions include Centennial prayers and thanksgiving services in synagogues, lectures on Canadian Jewish history a pictorial history program on Jewish life in western Canada via a slide series or film strip, the commissioning of a play based on the arrival and experiences of the first Russian Jewish immigrants in western Canada. An exhibition of the works of Jewish artists in western Canada was also recommended.

David Levin, Q.C., western regional chairman of Congress, told the seminar of Congress' concern to develop programs for use by other communities in the western region.
