

ELI CHERNIACK Fitting tribute to a man who has labored in the cause of Zionism and Jewish education and culture in Winnipeg for more than half a century will be paid Sunday, May 3, at a ban-quet at the Talmud Torah at 6.30 p. m. when citizens of the city will atend to honor Eli Cherniack. The event will also mark the 75th birthday anniversary of this beloved and ardent worker which he observed recently. One of the few remaining pioneers who first started the Zionist movement in the city, a fearless leader who espoused the cause of Zionism when it was considered a heresy, and one of the living leaders who helped lay the foundation of the Talmud Torah, Mr. Cherniack has lived to see the realization of many of his dreams. At the founding of the Talmud Torah 25 years ago he fought valiantly for the inclusion of Hebrew on the curriculum from seeing the ancient language reborn and used as the official tongue of the people in Eretz Israel. 
