The impressive roster of lecturers at the Teachers' Seminar includes: Dr. Sara Gaulan; the Hon. Yehuda Gaulan, Consul General of Israel; Moshe Arel, First Secretary of the Israeli Embassy in Ottawa; David Marmur, Director of the Research and Publications Department of the Israeli Office of Information in New York; and Prof. Benjamin Wolman,

guest lecturer in psychology at the Jewish Theological Seminary and the C.C.N.Y.

The program of the Teacher's Seminar will include Hebrew lectures on Fridays and Saturdays, which will be open to the general public.

IN MY VIEW

Dateline Montreal

MONTREAL.

Some weeks ago, before a Montreal taxi driver decided to bring me down a peg or two by hitting my left rear with his front right, a visitor from Western Canada had occasion to voice a complaint about this column.

"Why is it," he said, "you keep talking about the things that you find irritating and distasteful about the Canadian Jewish community.

Don't you think the readers are entitled to know the things you DO like?"

The obvious answer is yes, of course. Readers certainly are entitled to hear of the things I do find to my liking, at least as much as they listen to my complaints.

But, to be perfectly honest, the technique of newspapering, or columning, if you will, makes it rather difficult to emphasize or even equate the good with the bad. The reason is simply that for days you see such dull headlines in your daily newspapers as Prime Minister Diefenbaker's views on Commonwealth relations, or Ben Gurion's repeated assertions on the acceptable limits of Arabian

gall. With the dull headlines, the weather continues hot, cool or indifferent.

All of a sudden, a young lady by the name of Audrey whips up her skirts and sweeps them across a wide section of the continent in the form of a hurricane.

Immediately, Diefenbaker's Commonwealth views and Ben Gurion's assertions are buried inside the paper, to be replaced on Page one by the activities of Audrey.

Get the point? When a man bites dog, etc.

In any case, now that I have been asked what I do like, and for whatever interest it may be to those who read this column, here are some of the things that make me feel good

about living as a Jew in Canada: Most welcome experience, after having been away from Canada for close to a decade, is the manner in which young people have returned to the faith not only in the practice of their religion, but in their hyped interest in community welfare.

I like to see a young cousin of mine cutting a Saturday evening short because he has to be up early Sunday for a Bonds for Israel chore; I admire the interest of the young married couples in the parochial school system; most of all I like to see the young people crowding the synagogues — Orthodox or Conservative — on the high Holy Days, and attending

in greater numbers than ever on the Shabbes.

Credit this re-dedication to the faith on the birth of Israel, or on the horrendous phenomenon that was Adolph Hitler, but whatever the reason, I like it!

I also admire the intelligence of the Canadian Jewish community in their refusal to accept such splenetic philosophy as a Jewish anti-Zionism, which is far more insulting and embarrassing than any non-Jewish anti-Semitism. The Lillenthals are not for us!

It made me feel good, too, that in the recent unhappiness for the Liberal Party, no such thing developed on a national scale as a
