Manitoba's Legislature Hears Jewry's Tribute To King George

I rise as a Member of this House, on behalf of the Jewish people of Canada, to express their and my deep sorrow in the passing of one who has been a representative of an Empire for centuries maintained and perpetuated the most democratic system where each and everyone had his freedom and his free life... an Empire which has given a haven to my people, and a refuge in their dark day.

The greatest respect we can offer in his memory is to continue the free democratic system of life in the days and centuries to come.

May the Lord be his inheritance and may he repose in his resting place in peace.

The above words were spoken Wednesday by M. A. Gray, M.L.A. in tribute to the late King George VI at the sitting of the Manitoba Legislature, when members took their oath of allegiance to Queen Elizabeth II. They represent the first expression of sympathy voiced on behalf of Canadian Jewry, since the Manitoba Legislature was the only House in Canada to hold a sitting Wednesday.

Ganchoff, famed Columbia recording artist and member of the faculty of the Hebrew Union College School of Sacred Music, will be heard in a program of liturgical and folk music Sunday, Feb. 17, over CKY at 1:15 p.m. Cantor Ganchoff will present a concert program Wednesday, March 19, in Winnipeg under the auspices of the Shaarey Zedek Brotherhood Lecture series.

Shaarey Zedek Offers Youth Leadership Award

Shaarey Zedek Brotherhood, in association with the National Federation of Jewish Men's club, will sponsor a Youth Leadership Award, in the form of a Sterling Silver Medal to be awarded annually. Dr. Giat was called in as consulting specialist to set up an accelerated Hebrew instruction course, based on U.S. Army methods, to prepare the first batch of post-war G.I.s who left in 1946 for Jerusalem to study, under their G.I. benefits, at the Hebrew University. He also teaches rabbinical students and teachers at the Jewish Theological Seminary of America, Hebrew Union College-Jewish Institute of Religion, and Jewish Teachers' Seminary, and is equally respected as a teacher of Arabic.

In Winnipeg he will renew acquaintances with at least half a dozen former students of his at these various institutions in New York. Brotherhood officials this week indicated keen advance interest was being shown by Winnipeggers in Dr. Giat's subject, thrown into sharp relief recently when 150 dark-skinned Indian Jews sought to leave Israel and return home, motivated

by real or imagined discrimination. The history of the Yemenites in Israel has long been taken as a barometer of the progress in reintegrating widely divergent Jewish communities into a unified people again.
