Maimonides Students Vie For 'Jerusalem' Certificate

Two distinguished American Jewish pedagogues... Dr. Judah Pilch, director of the Jewish Education Committee of New York, and Dr. Azriel Eisenberg, associate director, during visits to Winnipeg during the past year commented on the high calibre student and advanced Hebrew curriculum offered at Maimonides College.

Both made suggestions to college president Rabbi Dr. A. Kravetz aimed at gearing the course of studies to the "Jerusalem Examinations" sponsored by the World Union for Hebrew Education, which Dr. Eisenberg heads.

These moves culminated just before Passover in a significant cultural achievement for Winnipeg Jewry when 11 senior students of Maimonides College wrote a seven hour series of exams, sponsored by the World Union. Successful candidates are awarded a certificate of achievement in Hebrew Culture, offered by the Hebrew University.

BIBLE AND NOVELS, TOO Admittedly difficult, the exams cover a wide area, ranging from Biblical literature to the contemporary Hebrew poets, and philosophical trends in modern Hebrew prose, fiction and non-fiction.

COMMUNITY BENEFITS Maimonides students have already taken their place as teachers and cantors in Winnipeg's Jewish schools and congregations, thus fulfilling one of the institution's stated aims: to prepare local qualified leadership in these fields.

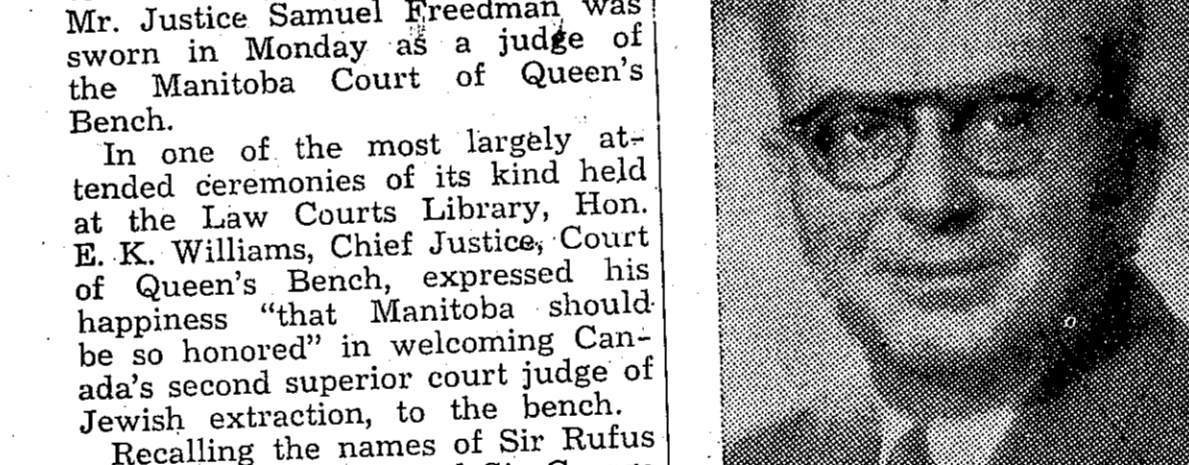

(1948) - (1952) Preliminary Stage 1947

November 29—The United Nations General Assembly, by a vote of 33 to 13 with 11 abstentions, passed a resolution recommending the partition of Palestine into a Jewish State, an Arab State, and an International one of Jerusalem, the three parts to be held together in an economic union, this settlement to come into force upon the termination of the British Mandate on May 15, 1948.

30—Arabs set fire to the Jewish Commercial Centre in Jerusalem. Arab attacks on Jews begin throughout the country, with the assistance of thousands of irregular Arab soldiers from neighboring countries infiltrating into Palestine as "volunteers."

1-20—"Operation Nakhshon": Three great convoys break through to Jerusalem providing the besieged and starving population with food, arms and ammunition.

15-17—The battle of Mishmar Haemek (settlement in the Valley of Esdrelon) on the government, Nationalist deputy J. L. Liebenberg insisted that the Africans people have aided the Jews "until they

21-22—After a twenty-four hour battle, Haifa is brought under the control of Haganah (Jewish Defense Force).

26-28—Haifa District British Police Headquarters report that "every effort is being made by the Jews to persuade the Arab populace to stay."

14—At a meeting of the thirty-seven member National Council, representing the Jews of Palestine and the World Zionist Movement, held in Tel Aviv, MR. DAVID BEN GURION READS THE ESTABLISHMENT OF MEDINAT YISRAEL—THE STATE OF ISRAEL.

President Truman informs the Israel representative in Washington, Mr. Eliahu Elath, of the United States de facto recognition of the State of Israel. (To be continued)
