

ROSENWALD ESTATE SUED FOR ENDORSEMENTS

Chicago. (WNS) — Because the late Julius Rosenwald had supreme faith in Sears, Roebuck & Co. which he headed, his estate has been sued for \$7,825,000, the amount due to the Chase National Bank because Rosenwald guaranteed to his employees that he would make good any losses they incurred through the drop in price of Sears, Roebuck stock. Another suit entered against the estate is one for \$150,000, representing a loan made by Mount Sinai Congregation here which Rosenwald endorsed at the First National Bank of Chicago. Both suits have been approved by Lessing Rosenwald, executor of the estate.

COHEN PLANS VISIT TO HOOVER

New York. (WNS) — A delegation of noted American writers has been organized by Elliot E. Cohen, former managing editor of the Menorah Journal, and now Secretary of the National Committee for the Defense of Political Prisoners, to go to Washington to protest Hoover against the eviction of the Bonus Expeditionary Force. Waldo Frank was also in the delegation.

WEIZMANN LAUDS AGENCY EXECUTIVE

London. (WNS) — A mild sensation was created at the sessions of the Administrative Committee of the Jewish Agency when Dr. Chaim Weizmann, who was deposed as President last year, praised the political activities of the present Executive and said that its work both in Jerusalem and London had been satisfactory. The present Executive had been elected last year on the charge that Weizmann's political activities were ineffective. Dr. Weizmann also declared that the British Cabinet today is very friendly to Jewish interests in Palestine, and that both Colonial Secretary Cumliffe-Lister and High Commissioner Wauchope could be counted upon as friends of the Jewish Agency.

A budget of 360,000 pounds was adopted by the Administrative Committee, although it was admitted that the outlook for the income of the Agency was not very bright. Efforts to reduce the budget drastically were opposed on the ground that such action would create an unsatisfactory atmosphere among Jews. Simon Marks, of London, offered to undertake the raising of a loan to provide the funds that could not be gotten through public subscription. He indicated that he might go to the United States to help in the raising of such a loan.

AGENCY ALSO REJECTS FRENCH REPORT

London. (WNS) — A resolution echoing the sentiment of the Zionist Actions Committee which had characterized the Lewis French Report as unacceptable for discussion was adopted by the Administrative Committee of the Jewish Agency. The sessions of the Committee were uniformly dull, except for the appearance of Dr. Chaim Weizmann, former Agency President, who delivered an address eulogizing the chutzpah and inferring that the present emphasis on private initiative in Palestine is misplaced and that the work of the national funds is more fundamental and effective.

REVISIONISTS RECOGNIZED AS SEPARATE GROUP

London. (WNS) — The Revisionists were recognized as a separate group within the World Zionist Organization in a resolution adopted at the final session of the Zionist Actions Committee here. The recognition was based on the proviso that the Revisionists would not conduct separate political negotiations with the British Government or the League of Nations. The action of the Committee, which was taken after a close vote, was interpreted as a victory for the Revisionists. Resolutions adopted by the Actions Committee included one urging greater discipline among Zionists and instructing the Organization Com-

mittee of the Executive to devise a formula for making the Jewish Agency more effective. The Actions Committee also adopted a message of encouragement to be sent to the opening of the conference at Geneva to consider the calling of a World Jewish Conference.

CONFIRMS MUSSOLINI FINANCE MINISTER A JEW

Paris. (WNS) — Enrico Jung, Italy's Minister of Finance, and occupant of one of the few posts that Benito Mussolini has not taken unto himself, is definitely an orthodox Jew, according to an account of Jung's life in the "Haint." Jung, a Trieste Jew, whose father came to Italy from Germany a half century ago, was just appointed to the post as a result of the Cabinet shakeup. A prominent merchant and orange exporter, Jung is not very closely allied with the Fascist Party. His commercial abilities are said to be solely responsible for his appointment, which gives Italy a Jewish Finance Minister for the second time, the first one having been Luigi Luzzatti.

NEW DECREE AIMED AT GERMAN VIOLENCE

Berlin. (WNS) — A decree intended to stop, or at least discourage, all political violence in Germany has been signed by President von Hindenburg at the suggestion of the Von Papen cabinet. Stringent measures, providing for death and other harsh penalties, are included within the decree as a result of the clashes between Hitlerites, Communists and other factions.

WARSAW SENDS IMPRESSIVE GROUP TO GENEVA

Warsaw. (WNS) — Evidence of the high hopes placed in the Geneva conference on August 14th by many Jews of Poland is found by observers in the high character of the delegation that has left here to attend the Swiss conclave which is to decide upon the convening of a World Jewish Congress, Members of the Polish delegation include D. Mazur, President of the Warsaw Kehillah, Deputy Rosmarin of the Seim, Isaac Gruenbaum, Rabbi S. Rubinstein, and representatives of the Jewish Merchants Association and of many of the large Jewish communities in Poland.

ARABS REJECT FRENCH REPORT

Jerusalem. (WNS) — The Lewis French Report is unacceptable to the Arabs of Palestine, the Arab Executive has decided. Its decision was made on the ostensible ground that the British agricultural investigator is too friendly to Jewish interests.

ADEN JEWS ORDER WOMEN VEILED

Aden, Arabia. (WNS) — Hereafter the Jewesses of Aden must resume their veils, which they had been abandoning, they cannot be out of doors after eight and they must leave the seashore by six. These regulations were adopted at a meeting of the Jewish community, which accepted the measures because of the recent clash between Arabs and Jews. The leaders asserted that Arabs have taken a greater interest in the Jewish girls since the latter dropped their veils. A number of cases of violence to Jewish women have been reported. At the same meeting it was reported that the High Commissioner of Aden had rejected the claims for damages done to Jewish property during the outbreak.

New Zionist Director to Attend Western Zion Convention

Rabbi Jesse Schwartz, executive director of the Zionist Organization of Canada, is coming to the Western Zionist Conference to be held in Winnipeg on September 4th, 5th and 6th. After the conference he will tour the West from Winnipeg to Vancouver on behalf of the United Palestine appeal and general Zionist propaganda. Rabbi Schwartz assumed his duties at executive direc-

tor on April 1, 1932. He recently returned from a successful tour through Ontario and the Maritime Provinces.

The new executive director of the Canadian Zionist Organization was born in New York City. He obtained his B. S. degree at the College of the City of New York, and the degree of LL.B. at the Columbia University Law School.

Rabbi Schwartz received his Jewish education privately and at the Jewish Theological Seminary of America from which he graduated in 1925. He has been an active Zionist worker from his youth, having been one of the organizers of the Young Judaea movement in the United States. He is well-known in American Zionist circles. He was at one time director of adult educational work in the Department of Education in the Zionist Organization of America.

Upon his graduation from the Jewish Theological Seminary, Rabbi Schwartz was called to the pulpit of the Goel Tzedec Synagogue in Toronto, where he was very active in Zionist work. He also participated in Zionist activities in a number of communities in Ontario. Rabbi Schwartz also occupied pulpits in Minneapolis and New Britain, Conn.

New Anti-Semitic Paper in Toronto

TORONTO. — A new anti-Semitic publication, patterned after the defunct "Dearborn Independent" of Henry Ford and utilizing the libels of the spurious Elders of Zion, will appear on the newsstands here on Monday.

A copy of the publication, which has reached the Jewish Telegraph Agency, reveals that England is the first target for attack for furthering Zionist aspirations.

The paper charges that the Elders of Zion first became a power under the late Theodore Herzl, Zionist leader, and as such are recorded in the minutes of the first Zionist Congress, held in Basle, in 1897.

This power has now been transferred to the Jewish Agency, the paper charges.

The publication also issues a warning to the Imperial Conference in Ottawa to beware of the Jews and the plans of the Elders of Zion, who are watching the proceedings and will form their future destructive activities accordingly.

Notwithstanding all these charges, the paper claims that it is not anti-Semitic.

It asserts that Britain is the home of the Lost Tribes and that the term British is derived from the words "Brith" and "Ish" of the Hebrew.

It is reported that the publication is supported by the anti-Semitic movement in Quebec.

Hadassah Conference High Lights

Registration of delegates will take place Saturday evening, September 3, and Sunday morning, September 4, at the Royal Alexandra Hotel. Mrs. I. R. Slavin is in charge.

There will be a Conference breakfast for all delegates on Tuesday morning, September 6, at 8.30. Official opening at 9.30 a.m.

The main function of the day will be the conference luncheon in honor of delegates and open to the public, at which Dr. May Bere-Mereminski will be the guest speaker and Mrs. Max Rady will preside.

Afternoon sessions will include reports of committees, discussions, reports of western chapters, papers on Hadassah subjects, addresses on National Fund, Keren Hayesod, propaganda, etc., vice-presidents report and closing addresses.

Western Zionist Centers To Be Represented At Conference

Saskatoon, Regina, Edmonton, Prince Albert and other Western Zionist points have notified that they will be well represented at the Western Zionist Conference in Winnipeg, Sunday and Monday, September 4 and 5. This, from a report of the activities submitted by A. M. Shimbane, chairman of the conference at the pre-conference meeting of organizations held in the Zionist hall, Wednesday, August 17.

Mr. Shimbane also reported that he is negotiating with some noted speaker to address the conference. Definite arrangements will be announced next week.

Several more local organizations have informed the meeting through their representatives, that they have appointed their delegates to the conference.

Report 155,606 Jews In Canada

Ottawa, Canada. (WNS) — There are 155,606 Jews in the Dominion of Canada, with most of them located in the Provinces of Ontario and Quebec, the latest census figures for the decade between 1921 and 1931 reveal. The Jewish population increased by 30,000 during that period, the statistics indicate. The population of the entire country is 10,736,786. The Catholics number 4,098,546.
