In 1962 she met and married the late Edward Hammer and moved to Vancouver, B.C. Rae resided there until Edward's passing in 1983, returning to Winnipeg for the remaining years of her life to be with her family.

She lived on her own until 1995, when failing health dictated a move to the Sharon Home.

SAUL FORDMAN

On June 5, 1996 Saul Fordman, age 94 years, after a lengthy illness at Seven Oaks General Hospital. He is survived by his loving wife Tillie whom he married 67 years ago, his daughters Reva Oman and Norma Chernick, and son-in-law Victor Chernick. Saul began his employment career as a paperboy on the corner of Portage and Main in the early 1920's which allowed him to meet and know the successful businessmen and bankers of the day. Once he founded Saul Fordman Ltd., with a small loan arranged by the President of one of the banks, the business flourished because of his honesty, attention to detail and friendliness to all including his customers, insurance company agents,

and employees. His business establishment on Garry Street was strictly business during the day but was a meeting place for all after work for a drink and friendly conversation at the "round" table.

He was feted by all on the occasion of his retirement and presented with a pewter plate signed by his employees, CEO's of numerous insurance companies and banks and other customers. This memento was treasured by him. Saul also was active in the community as a founder of the Hebrew Fraternal Lodge, and a member of the Montefiore Club, the Masonic Lodge and B'Nai Brith. He was a champion bowler and won numerous trophies during his earlier years.

The family is grateful to Dr. Norman Hechtenthal, the nurses and staff of the third and fifth floors at the Seven Oaks General Hospital for their excellent care and kindness during the final months of his life.

Austria enables heirs to benefit

NEW YORK (JTA) - The Austrian Fund for Victims of National Socialism has decided that payments from the fund could be inherited if claimants die before receiving their benefits.

The fund's supervisory committee said an application for the fund must have been filed before the claimant's death in order for the money to be inherited.

"It's very important to get the claim in," Elan Steinberg, executive director of the World Jewish Congress, said in an interview June 3.

The secretary general of the fund said she expected all the funds to be distributed in three to four years. The fund was created in June 1995 by the Austrian Parliament as a gesture toward victims of the Nazi regime in connection with the 50th anniversary of the re-establishment of the republic.

Steinberg said the decision about inheriting funds set Austria apart from most other countries involved in World War II restitution for Jews.

As of May 22, 3,280 claimants had received payments of \$7,000 each, for a total payment of about \$23 million. About 1,205 payments went to recipients in the United States.

The fund has data on 22,000 potential recipients, more than 8,000 of them from the United States.
