Annual Wolinsky Prizes Distributed In Jerusalem

An event looked forward to with much expectation by the students of Yeshivot and other religious educational schools in Israel is the annual distribution of the Joseph Wolinsky prizes. Now for the third successive year, this public function has become the gathering of the principals of all talmudic colleges throughout the country, together with the Chief Rabbinate, and co-sponsored by the Ministry of Religion.

Those receiving the awards are regarded as the outstanding theological students in the country, since the grading is made on merit, the final committee of selection being composed of the Minister of Religion and Chief Rabbi Dr. Isaac Herzog.

At the distribution, held recently in Jerusalem, Dr. Z. Warhaftig, Deputy Minister of Religion, who opened the proceedings, said that this was the third year that the prizes were awarded to those who had distinguished themselves in Jewish Law. In the first year 18 prizes were awarded, with 33 in the second year, and 59 in the present year. A great deal of merit was due to Joseph Wolinsky of Winnipeg, who had initiated these prizes, and had contributed towards them. Interest had grown in these awards, which were granted to outstanding students, and there were now 22 participating yeshivot.

Minister of Religion Moshe Shapira stressed that the spirit of the talmudic colleges, was the sure shield of defence for the survival of the Jewish people. They could take pride in the thousands of students who were now attending religious colleges, and were adding to the vitality of Jewish life in Israel. The spread of the teachings of the Torah was the only thing which could

deliver the Jewish people from degeneration.

World News in Brief United States

A proposal to revoke the Seventeenth Century excommunication of the philosopher Baruch de Spinoza has been rejected by the leaders of the Portuguese Jewish community here, descendants of those who originally banned the eminent scholar, the New York Times reported from Amsterdam. The suggestion to reconsider the 300-year-old measure came from David Ben Gurion, Israel's former Prime Minister.

To spread work for its members and to stimulate a drive for the reactivation of the Yiddish-language theatre, the Hebrew Actors Union has obtained a year's lease on three theatres in the metropolitan area. The latest to be added to the chain is Brooklyn's Parkway Theatre, which will open Oct. 7. The other two are the Elmsmere Theatre in the Bronx and the Second Avenue Theatre in Manhattan.
