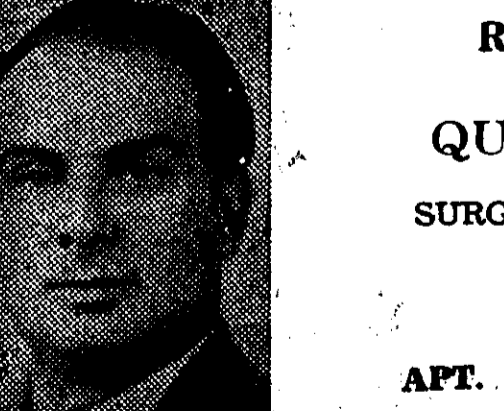

SUCCESSFUL HISTADRUT CONFERENCE HELD

The Histadrut Mid-West region conferences in smaller communities. This is the first in a series of conferences that are planned as annual events in order to bring top Israeli and Canadian Zionist leadership to the smaller communities of the Mid West region. At the conference opening on Saturday evening, A. Montague, Q.C., delighted his audience with a scholarly review of the contribution to Israel and the Jewish people by Histadrut since its inception almost half a century ago, prefacing his talk with an account of his early experiences as a Zionist speaker in rural Saskatchewan and Manitoba.



The highlight of the conference was the closing banquet attended by a large segment of the Regina Jewish community. Presentation was made by Bernard Morris, national executive director. Top centre — The Hon. Two seminars were held Sunday, May 18, the topics being "The Role of the Histadrut Today and Tomorrow", and "The Role of Histadrut in the Diaspora". Participants leading the discussion were Bernard Morris, national executive director of the Histadrut; Leo J. Moss, national executive director of the Labor Zionist Movement of Canada; Mrs. I. Brass, president, Pioneer Women Council of Winnipeg; Greg Brodsky, Robert Feldman, Robert Sattin, national vice-president of Histadrut, of Calgary, and Leon Mitchell, chairman, Winnipeg Histadrut Campaign. Spirited discussion was evoked by the excellent presentations of the seminar panelists.

During the afternoon session, officers for the region were elected: Yakir Freedman was elected president of the Mid-West region and three vice-presidents were named: Leon Mitchell of Winnipeg, Joe Bronstein of Regina, and Cecil Gordon of Saskatoon. Vocal selections in Jewish, Hebrew and English by Marcia Corrin, accompanied by Judy Weinberg on the accordion, enhanced the festivities.
