To all to whom these presents shall come—GREETING:
WHEREAS Section 3 (1) of The Coarse Grain Marketing Referendum Act provides as follows:

BALLOT
Do you wish to continue to sell your oats and barley as at present? Yes No

AND WHEREAS sections 4 and 5 of The Coarse Grain Marketing Referendum Act provides as follows:
"4. Subject to subsection (2), the Lieutenant-Governor may, by a proclamation issued pursuant to an order-in-council, fix the date on which the voting on the referendum shall take place; and the proclamation shall be published in at least three successive issues of The Manitoba Gazette and in such newspapers, published in Manitoba, as is specified in the order-in-council."
5. The Vote, except as herein otherwise provided, shall be taken in accordance with The Manitoba Election Act."

NOW KNOW YE that by and with the advice and consent of our Executive Council of Our Province of Manitoba, by virtue of the provisions of the said Act above referred to, and of all other power and authority whatsoever in Us vested in that behalf, we have ordered and declared and do hereby proclaim that the 24th day of November, A.D. 1951, is fixed as the day on which the voting on the referendum shall take place under The Coarse Grain Marketing Referendum Act.
