

Hebrew, Jewish Teachers Plan In-Service Program on March 28

An In-Service program for Hebrew and Jewish teachers in Winnipeg will take place on Tuesday, March 18, from 9 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. at the Joseph Wolinsky Collegiate, 427 Matheson Ave.

The In-Service will be co-sponsored by the Department of Education of the Winnipeg Jewish Community Council, the Federation of Hebrew and Jewish Teachers and the English Teachers' Association of the Winnipeg Jewish School system.

The In-Service will be oriented towards the day-to-day goals of local Jewish educational institutions. The comprehensive agenda

will cover a program relating to pressing educational problems to be reviewed by the In-Service workshops.

Heading the workshops will be two leading Canadian educators: Dr. Leon Kronitz, executive vice-president and director of education of the Canadian Zionist Federation, and the C.Z.F. Assistant director of education, Moshe Aharoni, both of Montreal.

Hebrew and Jewish teachers from other Western Canadian centres are being invited to attend the In-Service. The In-Service is being co-ordinated by L. Berger, president of the Federation of Hebrew and Jewish Teachers.

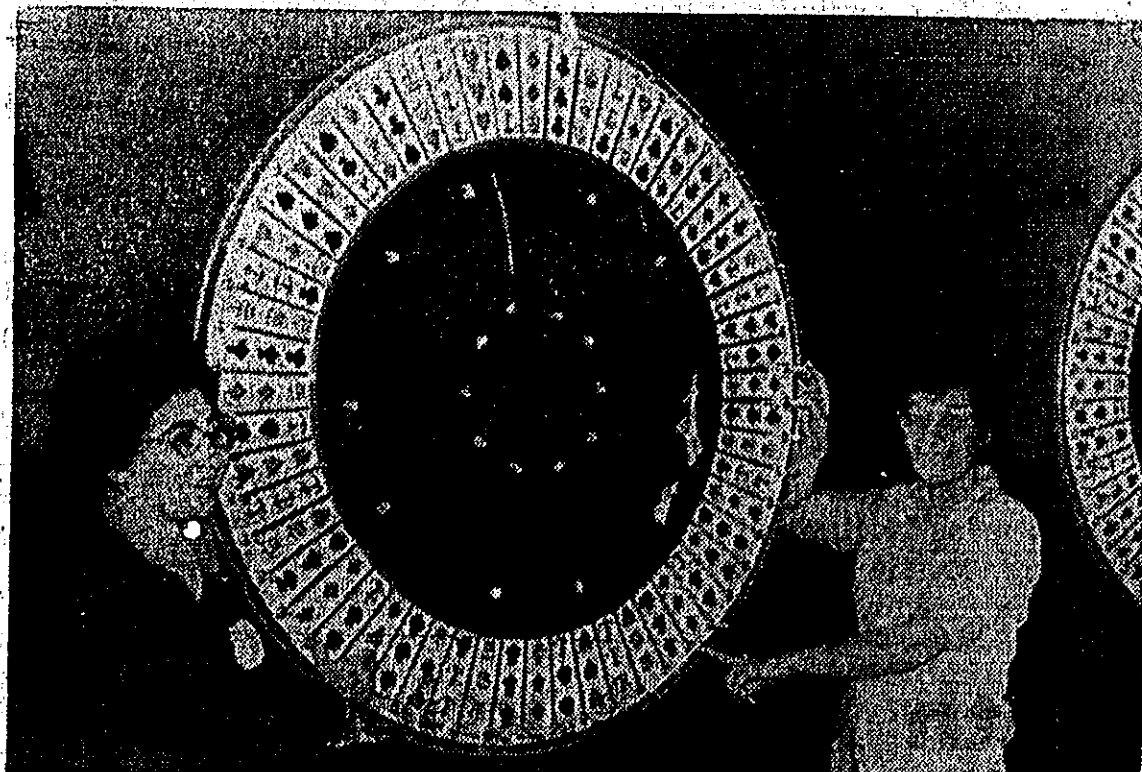

Carnival Tyme on Sunday



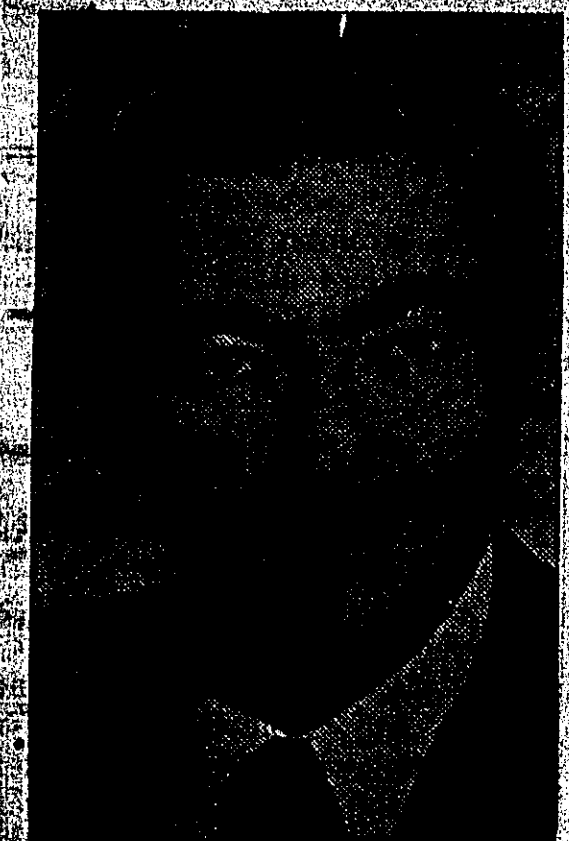
Sunny Kaminsky and Evelyn Maslowsky have hit it big on the wheel. Won't you come out and try your luck?

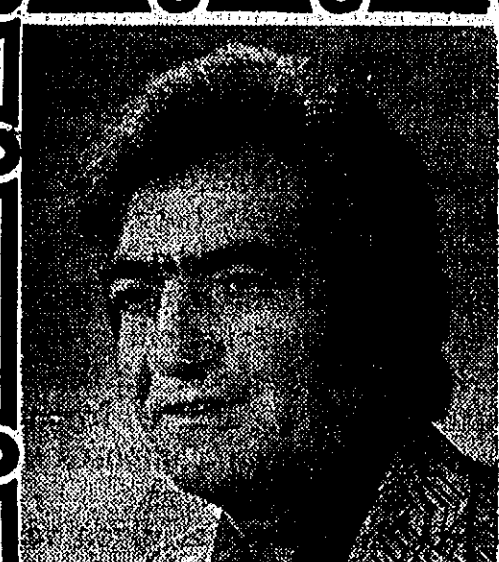

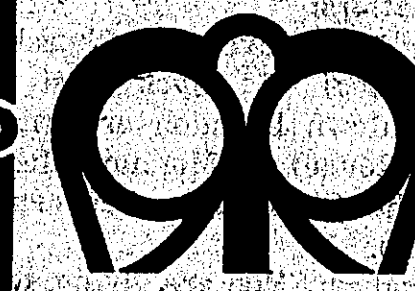

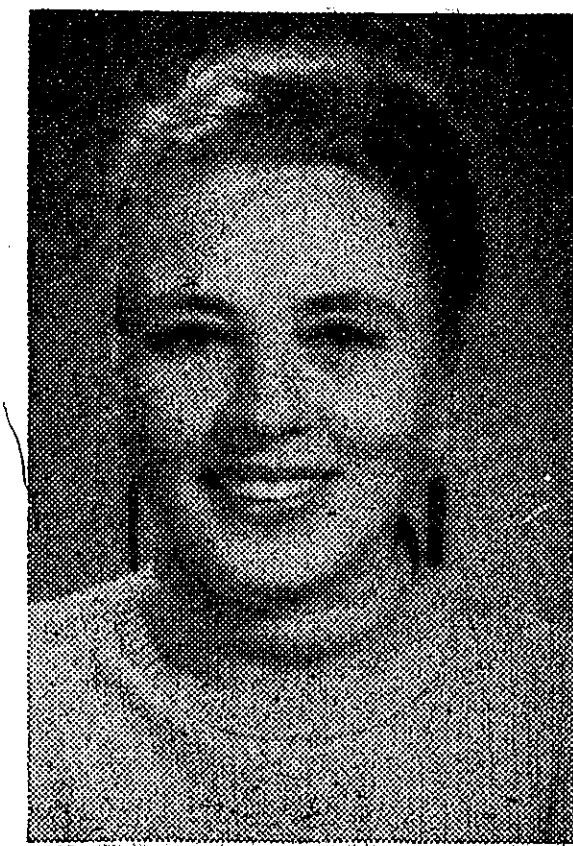
