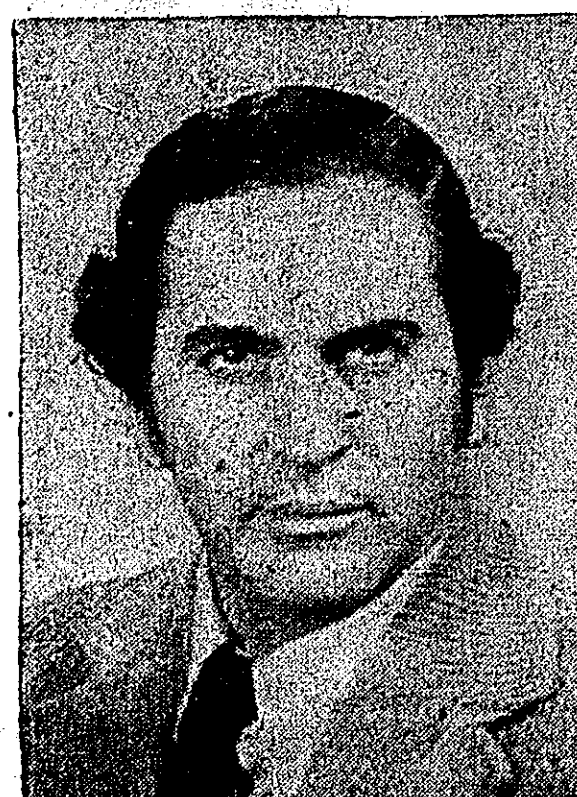


Hebrew as Second Language Topic Of Prof. Nahir's Talk to Teachers



PROFESSOR MOSHE NAHIR

Professor Moshe Nahir, of the Department of Near Eastern and Judaic Studies of the University of Manitoba, addressed the Hebrew Studies teachers of the Talmud Torah/Joseph Wolinsky Collegiate, the Peretz Folk School and the Ramah Hebrew School, at a luncheon-meeting at the YMHA, Friday, Oct. 24.

The topic of the address was Linguistics and Teaching Hebrew as a Second Language. This was followed by a seminar discussion session.

Dr. Emanuel Applebaum, principal of the Talmud Torah/Joseph Wolinsky Collegiate, chaired the meeting and introduced Professor Nahir.

Professor Nahir was recently appointed to the Faculty of the Department of Near Eastern and Judaic Studies of the University of Manitoba. He presently holds membership in the Linguistic Society of America, the Modern Language Association, the American Oriental Society, the National Association of Professors of Hebrew and the American Association for Jewish Studies. Before coming to Winnipeg, he was on the Faculty of the University of Wisconsin, Hebrew and Semitic Studies Department.

Israelis Accused Of Inhospitality

Jerusalem (JCN5) — A complaint that Israelis are still not hospitable enough to visitors has been made by the director-general of tourism, Avraham Rosenman. He told the press here that a big effort must be made to enable tourists to see more of the people of Israel and not only the country side. "My Ministry is actively engaged in studying ways to break down the 'ghetto walls' which surround most tourists," he said.

Tourism to Israel this year has continued to increase, and in September there were 53,000 visitors compared with 46,500 in September last year.

So far, the 1975 figures are only five per cent down over the first three-quarters of 1974.

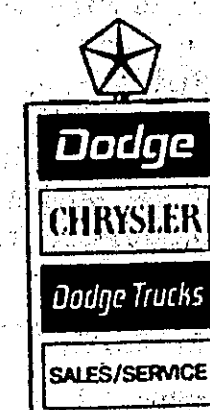
