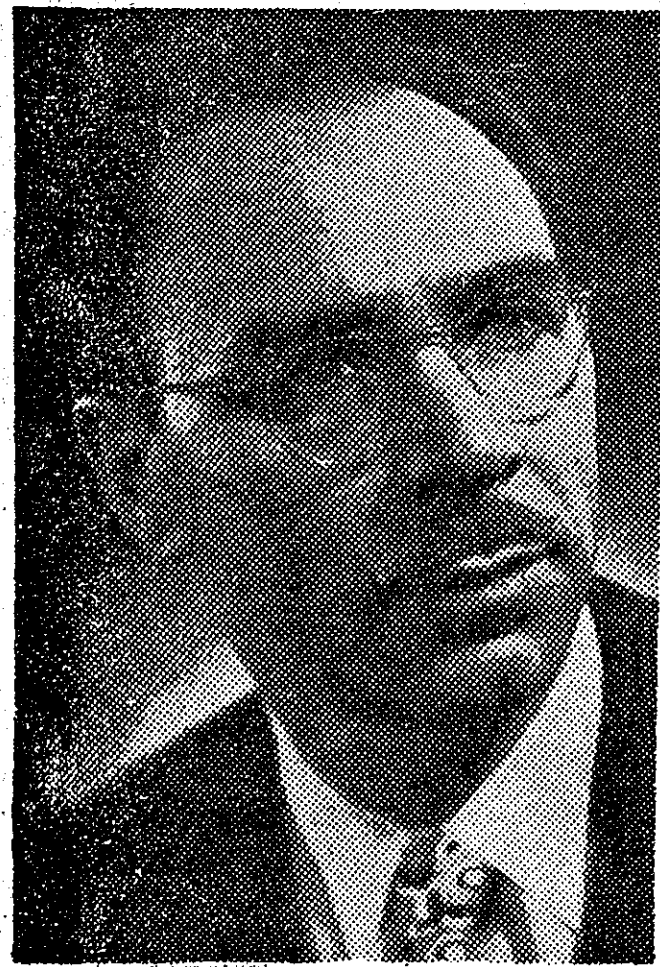
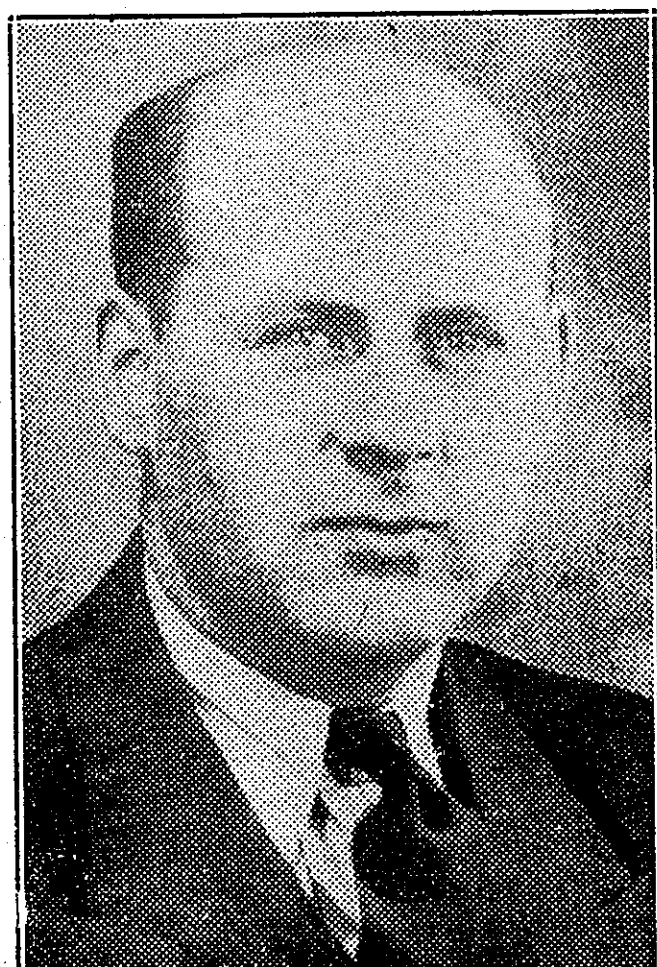


Rich ZCI Series Draws Membership to Zionists

A short-term drive for a limited number of new members will be conducted by Winnipeg's three men's Zionist clubs — Sharon Zionist Club, Chaim Weizmann Club and Brandeis Lodge — it was announced this week by officials of the clubs.

The drive is being conducted in conjunction with the opening of the

Zionist Cultural Institute on Oct. 21, and new membership will be limited to the capacity of the concert hall of the Civic Auditorium where Institute programs are held. High interest in this year's ZCI has already sparked "gratifying" re-enrollment from regular members.

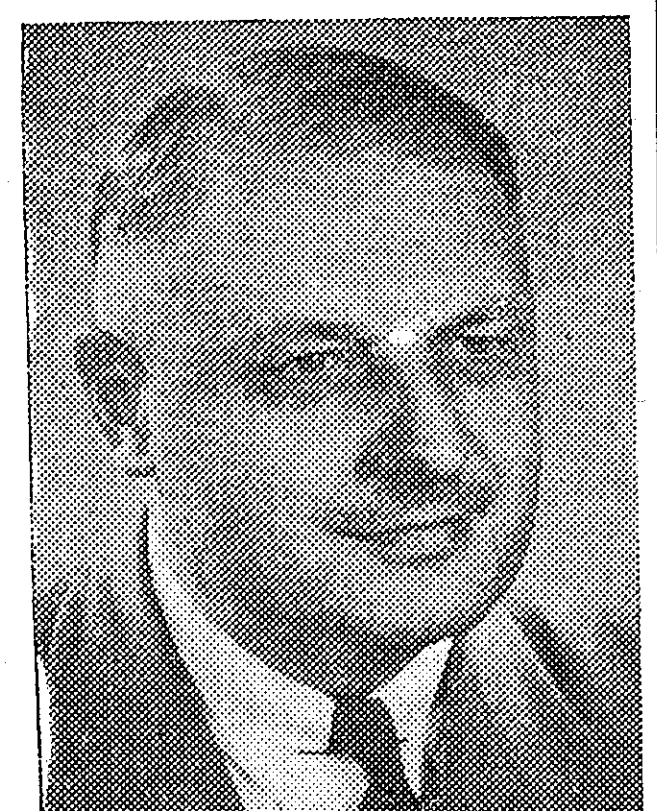

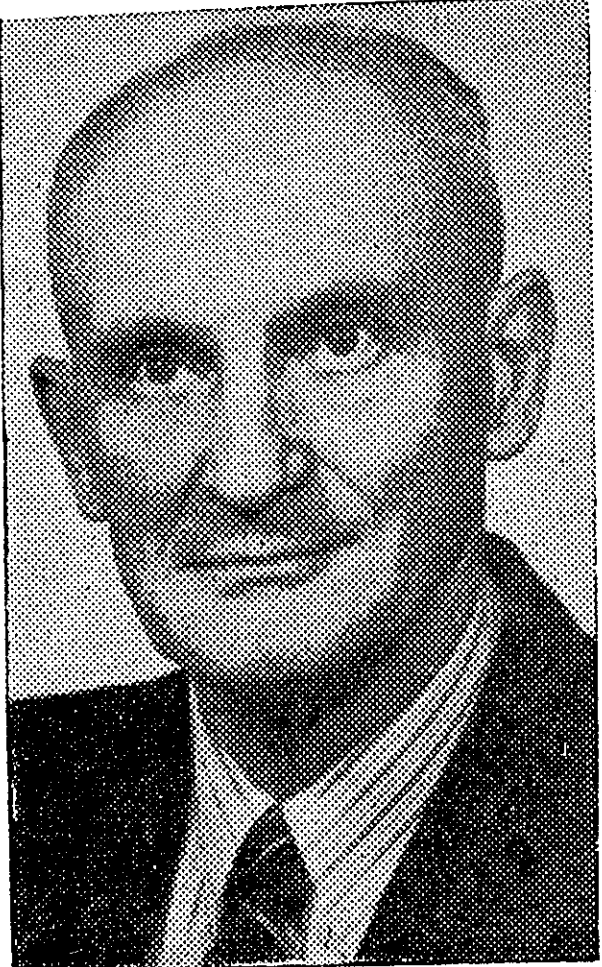

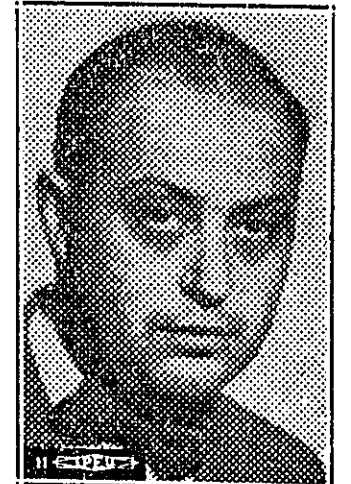
