Markson Spends Seder with Parents:

Siberian Exile Ends, Reunion in Israel after 29 Years



FREDA AND MOSES MARKSON

MR. AND MRS. JACK MARKSON, 131 Machray avenue, Winnipeg, left Wednesday for a trip to Israel on which, Im Yirtze Hashem, Mr. Markson will spend the Passover Sedorim with his parents whom he last saw 29 years ago, during the peaceful twenties, in Lithuania.

Moses and Freda Markson, who have spent fifteen years in Siberia for the crime of being "bourgeois traders", arrived in Israel last October, as one of the very few Jewish families permitted to leave the Soviet paradise for Israel.

They were recently visited in Jerusalem by their son Sam Markson of Saskatoon. Jack Markson, whose long-planned reunion with his eighty-year-old father and mother was delayed recently by emergency surgery, related his family's recent history just before embarking on his 'pilgrimage' Wednesday.

In Pilvishky, Lithuania (adjacent to Kovno) the Marksons were well established as exporters of grain and

line, to insure safe delivery of the parcels. In Jerusalem, the Marksons will spend Pesach with their parents, a brother, Max Markson (an Israeli engineer), and a sister and her family, Mrs. M. Freedman, also a Jerusalem resident.

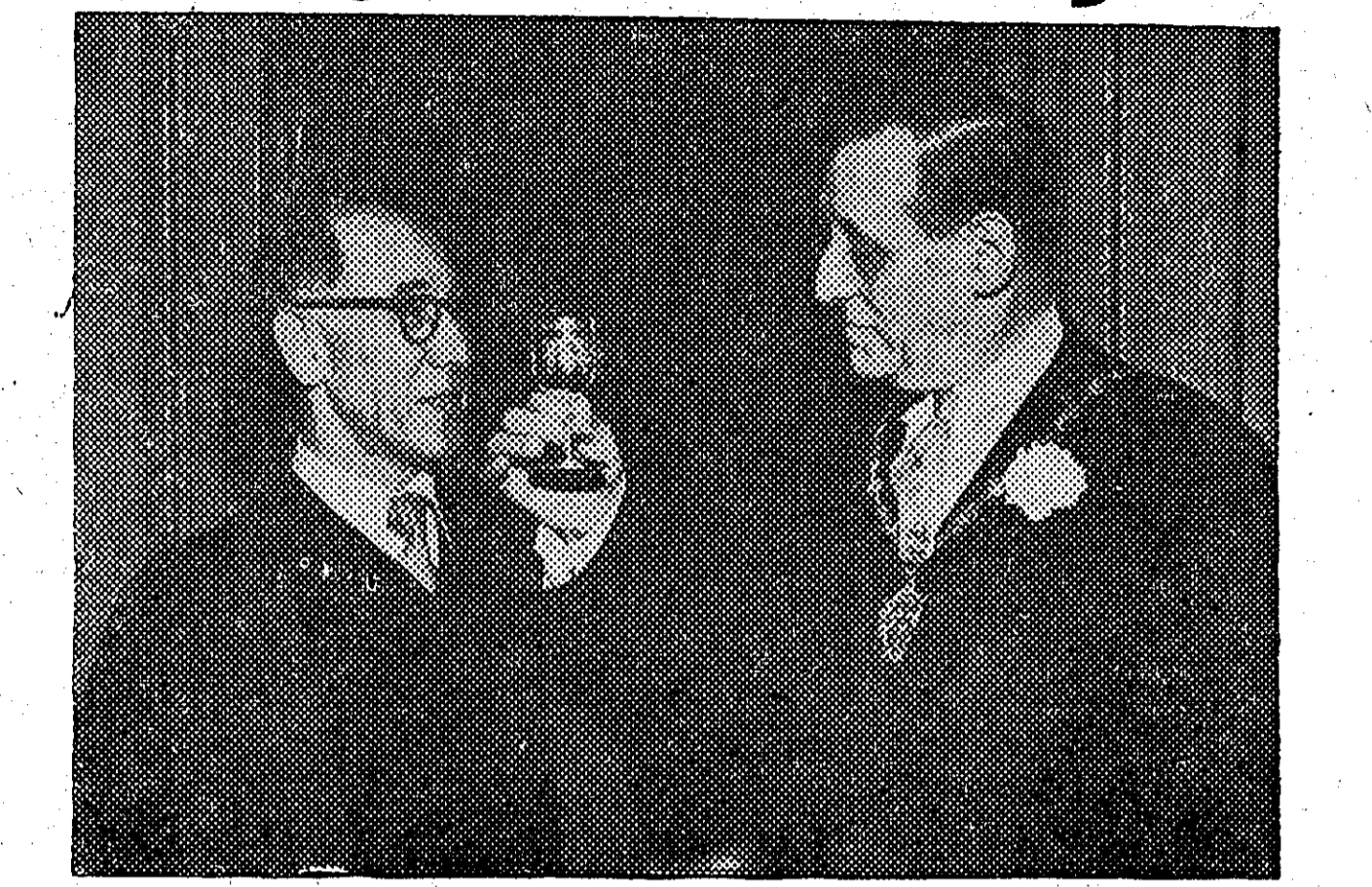
