ZELDA ROSENTHAL.
Mrs. Zeldia Rosenthal, late of the Sharon Home, passed away after a brief illness, on Sunday, July 20, 1980.
Born in Rumania as Zeldia Barish, Mrs. Rosenthal immigrated to Canada, together with her late parents, and took up residence in Winnipeg in 1928. In 1932, she moved to Buenos Aires, Argentina, to marry Meyer Rosenthal. They were in residence and business there until 1964, at which time they returned to Winnipeg to be with Zeldia's brother and sister-in-law and their family.

Zeldia Rosenthal was a devoted wife, sister, and aunt. She lived her life in accord with Jewish precepts and traditions, and was beloved by all her family and by her many good friends. She responded to people and was respected by all with whom she came in contact.

She was active in the Golden Age Club, where she participated in and enjoyed all the activities offered by the club, especially the handicraft program.

Zeldia Rosenthal is survived by her brother and sister-in-law, Jack and Mary Barish of Winnipeg; her nephews and nieces Moishe and Baila Weisenberg of Netanya, Israel, Evelyn and Leo Weiss, Earl and Judy Barish, all of Winnipeg, Sid and Frances Barish of Toronto, Sally and Arnold Bookbinder, of Los Angeles; and their children who were all loving grand-nephews and grand-nieces to Zeldia, and on whom she doted.

On Monday, July 21, services were conducted at the Chesed Shel Emes Chapel, with Rabbi Peretz Weizman officiating. Interment was at the Hebrew Sick Benefit Cemetery.

Suddenly, on Thursday, July 31, 1980, Nathan Garfinkel, beloved husband of Rose Garfinkel, passed away at his summer home at Winnipeg Beach.

Besides his wife, he is survived by his son Irvin and daughter-in-law Shirley, daughter Rita Vine and her husband Alec, sisters Rose Wilder of Winnipeg and Molly Zolot of Boston, and five grandchildren, Reesa and Harvey Garfinkel, Dr. Martin and Karen Vine, and Cindy Vine, as well as a great many relatives and friends.

Mr. Garfinkel was born in Mezeritsh, Poland, on December 20, 1900 and came to Canada at a very early age. He was instrumental in bringing a large number of his family members to Canada from Mezeritsh as well as bringing out a number of his townspeople to Canada after World War II. Mr. Garfinkel was active in community affairs and was a staunch worker and supporter of B'nai B'rith. He actively engaged in UJA and UIA campaigns with success. He was also secretary of the Winnipeg Chess Club for many years and participated in a number of international tournaments. He was a member of the Beth Israel Synagogue.

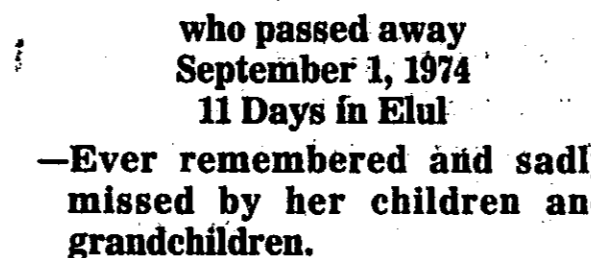

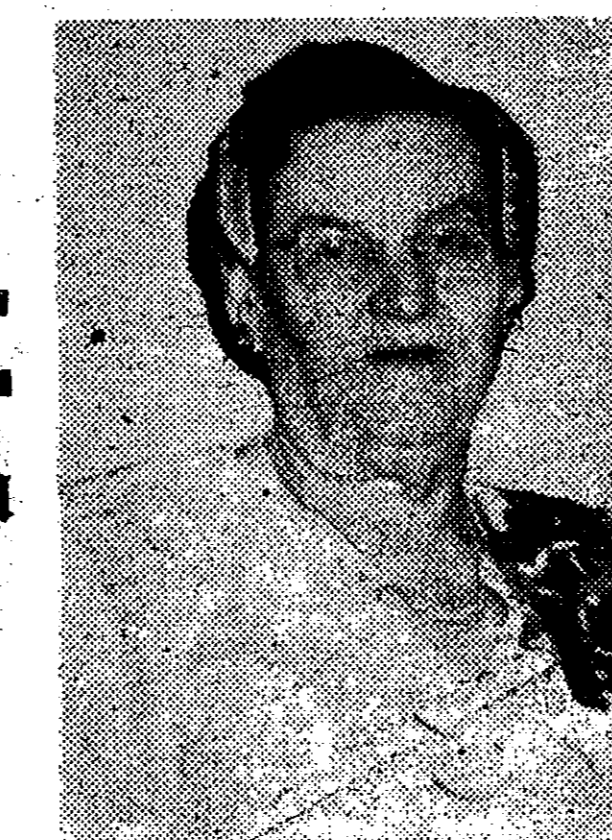

Due to the High Holy Days, Adult Leisure programs will not be held during September. Regular programming will resume in October.

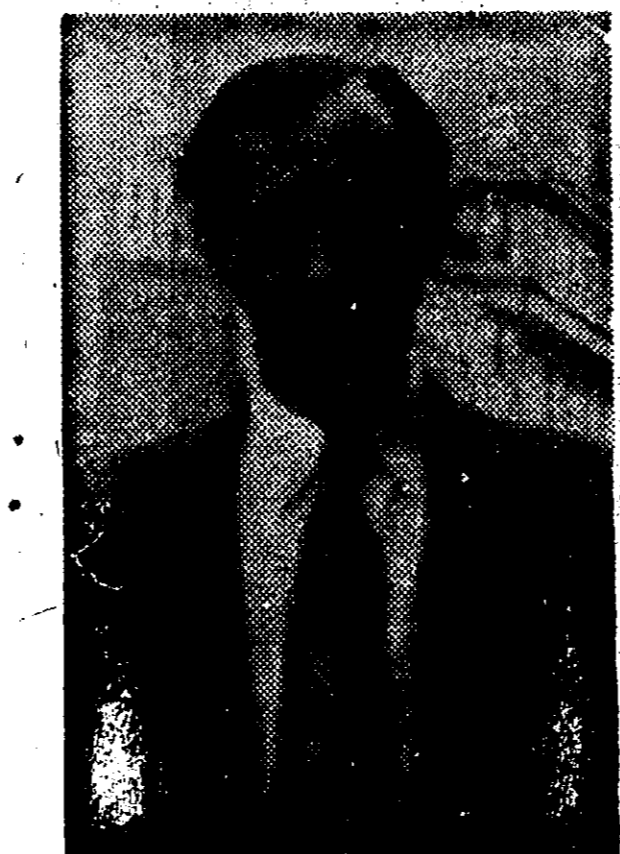
B'NAI B'RITH WOMEN
