**500 Attend Closing Function
Of Ussishkin Memorial Project**

Close to five hundred Jewish citizens gathered at a dinner on Sunday evening in the Talmud Torah auditorium to mark the close of the Ussishkin Memorial month. The affair was arranged by the Jewish National Fund council and R. Hamovich, president, presided.

Tribute to the memory of the great and beloved Jewish leader, Menachem Mendel Ussishkin, who was in a large measure responsible for the growth of the Jewish National fund, was paid by Rabbi Oscar Z. Fasman, of Ottawa, the guest speaker. The iron will and stubborn determination of Ussishkin to create land for the Jewish Homeland in Eretz Israel was emphasized by the speaker.

Speaking of Palestine Rabbi Fasman said that all the Jewish people asked for was justice. We are asking for a chance to acquire that which is ours and we will pay for it. We will have our own soldiers to protect and defend it. We don't want to conquer anybody, he said.

Rabbi Fasman reminded his audience that the Jews would face a problem when the United Nations won the war in the rebuilding of the homeland of Israel. If the enemy should win he told them they would not have to worry about how their homeland was to be rebuilt. "They would tell us what to do, any you all know what that would be."

A feature of the evening was the presentation to D. Selter, honorary vice-president of the Zionist organization of Canada, of a certificate in the Ussishkin Golden Book for his exemplary services to the cause of Zion. The presentation was made by H. Sokolov, president of the Winnipeg Zionist council.

Others who were presented with Golden Book certificates included: Mrs. Dena Panar, Mr. and Mrs. P. Mass, Allan Gottlieb (two certificates), Mr. and Mrs. D. Freed, Mrs. M. Freed (in the name of her late beloved husband), Mrs. Sarah Levine, Mr. and Mrs. J. Churchill, Mr. Isaac Bereskin, Mr. and Mrs. Michael Tessler, Mrs. L. Schwartz and Mrs. L. Thomin, Mrs. L. Shusky president of Winnipeg Hadassah council, made the presentations.

Greetings were extended to the gathering by A. I. Boroditsky on behalf of the Mizrahi organization, and for the Peale Zion by Alderman M. A. Gray, M.L.A.

The chairman announced that inscriptions were being made in the Ussishkin Golden Book by the following organizations: The Hebrew Fraternal lodge, Zion Free Loan, Rachel Blosstein chapter, inscribing the names of Mrs. Sarah Frankel and Mrs. Agnes Endelman; The Peale Zion organization inscribing the name of the late S. Abraham; The Peale Zion Pioneer Women inscribing the names of Mr. and Mrs. D. Soudack; the Mizrahi Men and Women's organization, Winnipeg Young Judea and the Habonim.

Mrs. D. Freed presented a cheque for \$500 to the Ussishkin Memorial fund

on behalf of the Winnipeg Hadassah chapter. The chairman thanked Mrs. D. Freed, Mrs. H. Sokolov and P. L. Fingerote for their assistance.
