Child Prodigy

Saskatoon (Special) — When he was only four years old, Jerry Sandbrand started to "throw" his voice around the house. His parents — Mr. and Mrs. Joe Sandbrand — would hear a puppy whimpering in a corner of the room; but there was nothing in the corner. They very quickly learned that such goings-on were the product of little Jerry's natural talent for ventriloquism.

Today, at 14, Jerry is a skilled and popular ventriloquist who has entertained large gatherings, as well as having performed on both TV and radio broadcasts.

And, like any top artist, Jerry has reached his present proficiency through adding study and practice to his natural talent. He experimented with his voice, read books on ventriloquism, studied the techniques of expert ventriloquists.

His parents share credit, too. From the first signs of his natural ability, they encouraged him. His first "professional partner" was Mickey Mouse — a small hand puppet brought back by his father from a trip to New York.

Jerry Practised every day, from 15 minutes to half-an-hour, until he and the dummy were a smooth "team." He wrote his own scripts and made up his own wisecracks.

Four years ago his father brought back a new "partner" from New York — Danny O'Day — and Jerry was all set. He entertained a Magicians Convention in Saskatoon, and his popularity began to grow by leaps and bounds.

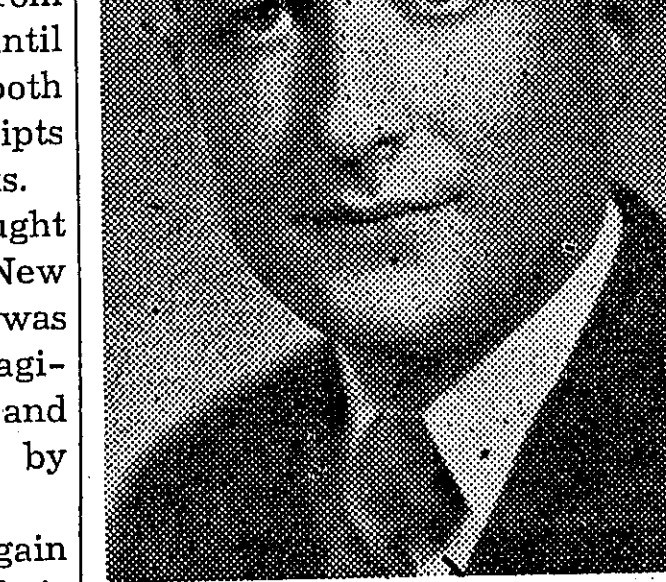

Zionist must be involved in a many-fold relationship with Israel, just as every Israeli must be involved in a many-fold relationship with the Jewries abroad. The Israel-global Jewish relationship must be based on creative reciprocity and application of the great moral ideals of our people.

IT ALSO REQUIRES the discipline of study — Zionists should send their children to Israel to study the Hebrew language in its mother country. However, a Jewish state has never been the exclusive or overriding aim of Zionism.

THIS MEANS that American Zionism will have to undergo great changes, perhaps a transformation of its character. Unlike Zionism in Eastern and Central Europe, American Zionism was primarily engaged in political work and fund-raising.
