Award Winner

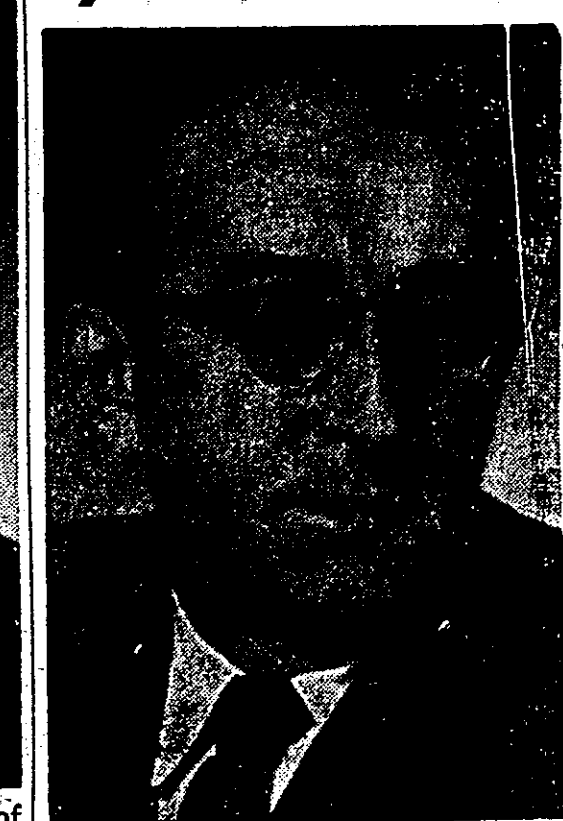

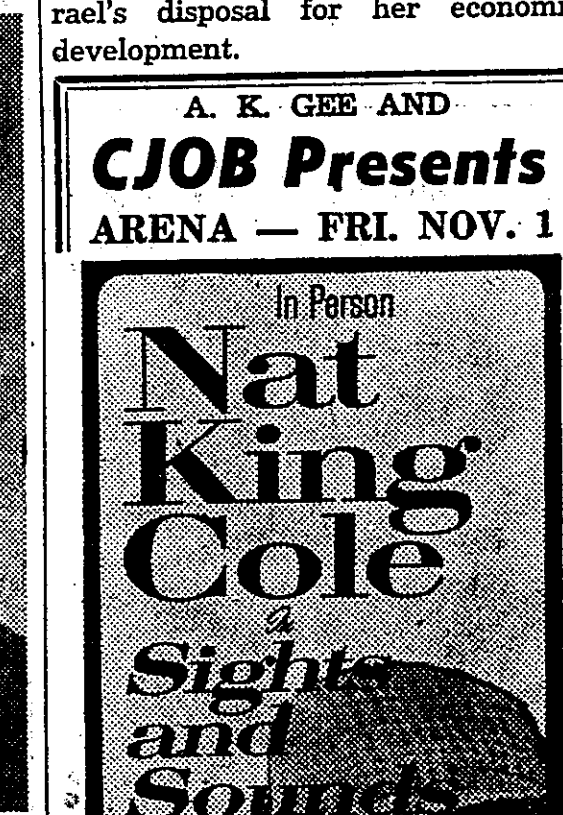
Record Purchase By Hebrew Frat.

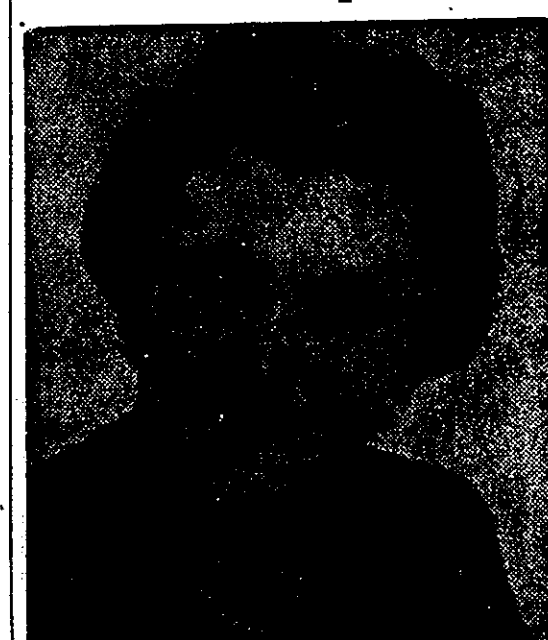
