## The Final Verdict

Tel Aviv (ZENS) — Neither the Knesset nor the courts are qualified to determine who is a Jew; only the Halacha can resolve this question. And the Halacha clearly specifies: Only a child born to a Jewish mother is automatically considered Jewish; a child mothered by a non-Jewish woman, even though fathered by a Jew, cannot be considered Jewish, unless it is converted to the Jewish religion. This is the irrevocable verdict of the Israeli Rabbinate and this decision is not subject to compromise — Rabbi Unterman contends. To questions by a journalist as to what would happen should the Soviet Union lift her iron curtain and allow her Jews to emigrate to Israel, and among them be couples of mixed marriages; and what would happen, if immigrants from the United States and Europe of mixed marriages would come to Israel, — Rabbi Unterman replied: "Immigrants come to Israel because they identify with the Jewish people and must therefore go through the process of conversion." Rabbi Unterman further warned that every effort by non-religious circles, or the Israeli courts to alter the Halacha would lead to dissension and cleavage among the Jewish people.
